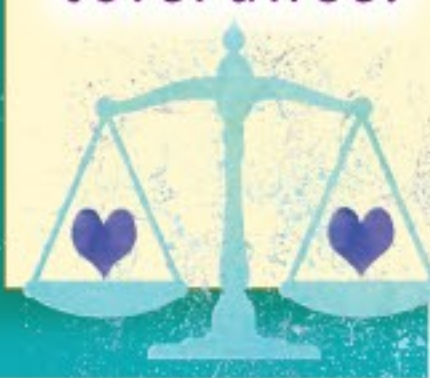


RESTORING HARMONY

Q: I am happy to write to you. My wife is not an ECKist. What can I do to avoid feeling resentful toward her when I go with my children to ECK activities without her?

The antidotes are forgiveness and tolerance.



A: Dear Saiba,

It can be very hard when a husband and wife follow separate religions. The blessing in your home is that she lets your children accompany you to ECK events.

You can't control your wife, only yourself. Know that resentment is a form of anger, whose antidotes are forgiveness and tolerance. So they are what you can practice to restore harmony to your home.

These spiritual disciplines are often difficult, but they can be ever so fruitful.

Q: My four-year-old daughter wakes up every night screaming and crying. It goes on for hours. She can't tell us what's wrong, and we have tried everything we can think of to help her. I am afraid. Can you help?
